We have been talking to the older children about keeping safe in the local community over the holidays after several incidents have been brought to our attention. Please ensure that you know where your children are and what they are doing.

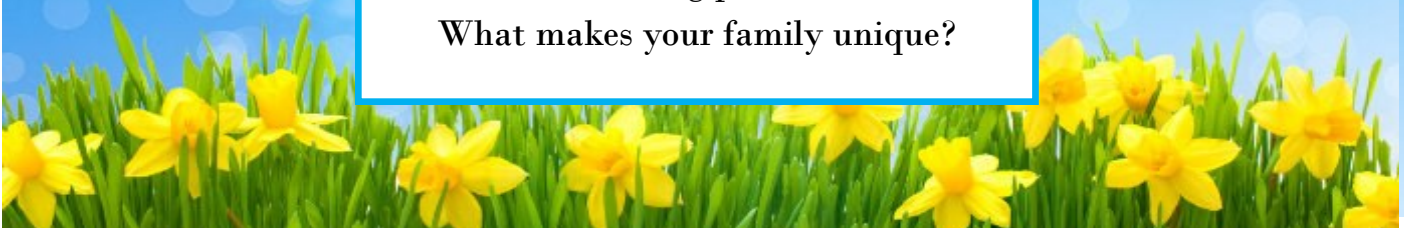
Reminder: school dinners are available for Hopsotch/Hedgehog children after the holidays. These must be ordered and paid for at least the day before via Scopay.
